
We congratulate John and Merrill on creating a long-standing, successful golf fundraiser and thank them for the honor of being the beneficiary for the past five years. Since 2020, more than \$75,000 has been raised for CPL to further our mission of increasing the independence and quality of life for individuals with disabilities, or who are in other situations of need. This year alone John raised over \$20,000 for CPL. **Thank you to all who participated, the success of this event is because of you.**



## FACILITY ENHANCEMENTS

The Gerret and Tatiana Copeland Kennel, located on CPL's campus in Cochranville, PA, houses dogs during their second year of training. Originally constructed in the Fall of 1999, we've seen more than 1,100 dogs fed and cared for in the kennel over the past 20+ years, and you can imagine how it has experienced significant wear and tear. Last year, we focused on repairing, modernizing, and streamlining the kitchen and grooming room. Updates included refacing the cabinets, adding drawers to safely store dog food, installing new appliances, and so much more!

This year, the Cuddle Room was given fresh coat of paint, choosing colors with the dogs in mind to promote a calming and relaxing environment for them and our Cuddle Time Volunteers. In celebration of CPL's 35th anniversary rebrand, the colorful walls in the Marian S. Ware Program Services Building were painted to showcase CPL's new brand colors. Thank you to CPL volunteer, John Sherman, for helping to complete the painting projects, as well as generously donating his time throughout year to mow the 45 acres on campus! Additionally, thanks to our many corporate volunteer groups throughout the year managing weeds and deep cleaning buildings and vehicles! We also added turf to one of the play yards, which allows grass to grow through, helping keep the turf in place, and providing the dogs with a safe and clean environment to play in. Some of you may recall, prior to installation of turf the yard would get muddy after it had rained, and could not be utilized for play time. Now, it can be used regardless of the weather!



Looking to the future, CPL has plans to paint the Training Barn and Kennel Kitchen. And due to the success of the turf play yard we will be securing funds to add additional turf to the larger grass play yard at the Kennel. We estimate this will cost approximately \$12,000. 



# THE IMPORTANCE OF SOCIALIZATION AND SERVICE DOG ETIQUETTE

Socialization plays a key role in the development of a future service dog's training. Whether they are learning how to walk nicely alongside their partner, how to wait in line at the store, or how to react to unsolicited attention, public socialization is the key to success. From the moment CPL puppies turn eight weeks old, they are introduced to the world around them, travelling to new and familiar environments with their puppy raisers – the dentist, the grocery store, concerts, college tours, and more! Socializing future service dogs in public gives them the opportunity to explore their environment and associate positive feelings with public access. This socialization can also contribute to lessened feelings of fear and anxiety when out in public with their puppy raiser or trainer, allowing for a more successful training session.



The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) states that, "businesses and organizations that serve the public generally must allow service animals to accompany people with disabilities in all areas of the facility where the public is allowed to go". An example of an exception to this is for example if their handler is in surgery and the surgical room must be kept sterilized for the safety of that individual. The ADA does not specifically mention service dogs in training; however most states have individual laws regarding the public access rights of service dogs in training. When working with a service dog in training, it is best to research the individual laws of the state you are in.

Remember, it's important that service dogs, and even some in training, are not pet, interacted with, or spoken to while in public, unless otherwise stated by their puppy raiser, trainer, or handler. While in work mode, service dogs and those in training should be giving their undivided attention to their handler, therefore, it is best practice to always ask before petting a working dog. CPL puppies in their first year of training wear capes that say, "Service Dog in Training" and are working with their handler to have positive interactions with humans in public. You can help with this by asking the puppy's handler if you can pet them and waiting for the puppy to sit (and stay seated) while you pet. For CPL dogs in their second year of training, they are no longer practicing public interactions and you'll see them out wearing their "Do Not Pet" vests. During this phase of training, they are learning to ignore distractions and stay focused on their handler. Distracting a service dog can result in that dog missing an oncoming medical episode or cue from their handler, which can cause serious harm or injury to that individual. Thank you for helping us train future service dogs through your interactions in public!
