














AN UPDATE

from CPL's Executive Director

As we welcome 2025, the CPL team and Board of Directors are reflecting on the accomplishments of the past year which was made possible because of the dedication and support of our CPL family, our volunteers who give of their time and talents and our dedicated donors through their generosity.

At a recent Independence Society event, we shared that CPL's website and logo, launched in February 2024, received two prestigious national awards. This successful endeavor was led by the CPL management team and talented staff at First Ascent Design with input from our clients, donors, volunteers, and staff. The project was also recognized as a finalist in the 4th annual Anthem Awards, in the category of non-profit's, diversity, equality and inclusion. Also in 2024, CPL entered into an exciting new partnership with Jordan Detection **K9.** CPL dogs who do not have the specific qualities of a service or companion dog, and who show us they would be happier and more successful in a career that meets their natural talents will be evaluated by Jordan Detection K9. Their staff train dogs to assist investigators with drug cases, child exploitation, counter terrorism, and white-collar crimes. These dogs are also trained to detect accelerants and electronic storage media. 



VET SPONSOR SPOTLIGHT

CREST VIEW ANIMAL CLINIC

Crest View Animal Clinic started as a mixed animal practice, treating both large and small animals, in the mid 1970's. Dr. Harry Sachs purchased the companion animal portion, meaning household pets like cats and dogs, in February of 1997. At that time, the practice had approximately 800 clients. Crest View Animal Clinic, located in Lincoln University, now has more than 2,500 clients. Since 2019, Crest View Animal Clinic has generously sponsored over 20 dogs for Canine Partners for Life. This includes wellness visits for our young puppies, checkups when a puppy is not feeling their best, and additional services like a neuter/spay. The staff at Crest View are exceptional at what they do and always approach each new puppy with open arms. Another way Crest View supports CPL is by facilitating donated shipments of Heartgard and Nexgard from another CPL supporter, Boehringer Ingelheim Animal Health (BI). BI generously



donates needed flea/tick and heartworm preventatives for CPL dogs in their second year of training. These donations are required to be shipped to a veterinary practice, and Crest View graciously accepts these shipments on behalf of CPL. 
SUPPORTER SPOTLIGHT THE PATTERSON FOUNDATION
