ADVANCING JUSTICE IN MORE WAYS THAN ONE

Jordan Detection K9, located in Indianapolis, Indiana, trains dogs to locate electronic devices, which can be crucial in criminal cases involving child exploitation, terrorism, white-collar crimes, and more. Since the program was established in

2015, Jordan Detection K9 has trained and deployed over 200 K9 officers, found over 1,000 devices, and recovered more than 300 victims in criminal cases. CPL's new partnership with Jordan Detection K9 began in 2024 so that dogs who may not be a good fit for our program can still serve in another way that is best suited for them. CPL's Simon and Doug were released from the service dog training program, but Jordan Detection K9 saw all of the right qualities in them for electronic storage detection (ESDK9) work. Simon now works for the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, and Doug works for the Lycoming County District Attorney's Office – both as ESD K9s.



Raising Hope: A Special Bond Between Inmates and Future Service Dogs

CPL's Prison Puppy Raising Program offers incarcerated individuals a unique opportunity to give back by training future service and companion dogs for those in need. Raising a service dog in-training brings purpose and responsibility to their prison experience, fostering personal growth and rehabilitation.



"The puppies have helped me more than I could ever have helped them, by teaching me it's bigger than me. It's about giving back to others."

One incarcerated handler shared, "I love that the program allows us, inmates, to participate in something so life changing while incarcerated. I would have never thought that this was possible coming to prison, and I'm very grateful." Knowing that the dog they're helping to train will one day support someone with a disability provides a powerful sense of contribution and self-worth — something often difficult to find in a prison setting.

"It means everything to me to be able to contribute to society in a tangible way, but my participation in the puppy program is not entirely selfless. Being loved by a dog is the purest form of love: It is a gift that I am grateful to receive every day, even while in prison."

"Volunteering for CPL allows me to not only work towards CPL's mission, but it allows me to see inmates be able to give back to their community.
