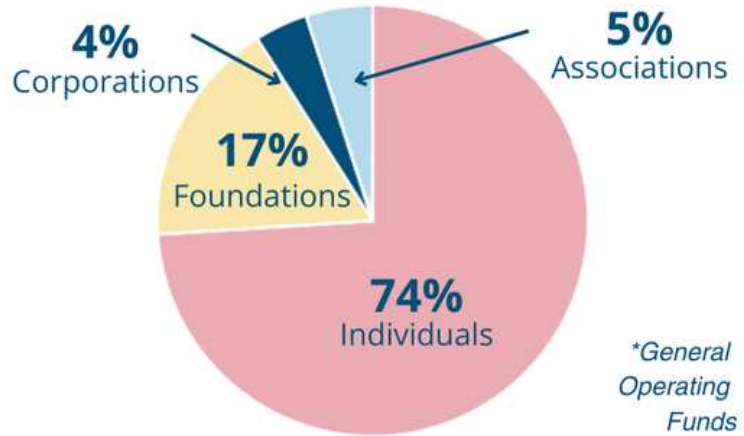

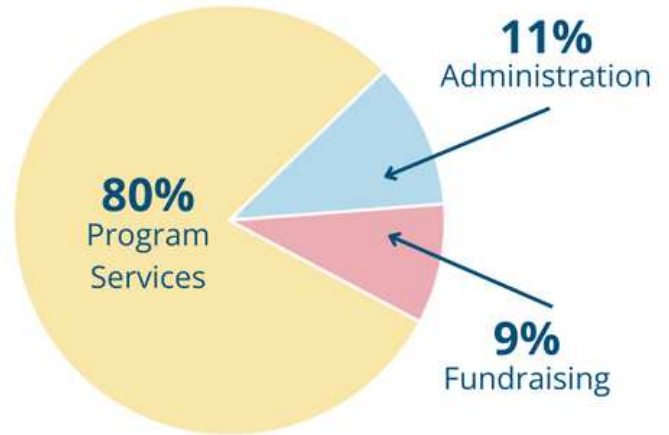

# Fit for the Job

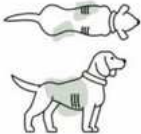
## Why a Healthy Weight Matters for Your Service Dog

Maintaining your dog's health is essential, especially for service dogs who work every day to support their handlers. One of the most important aspects of canine health is maintaining a healthy weight. While ideal weight can vary by breed, age, and activity level, there are a few general guidelines to keep in mind.



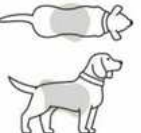
### Very Underweight

- Ribs, spine & hips bones are very easy to see
- Very obvious waist & abdominal tuck
- No fat can be felt



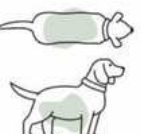
### Underweight

- Ribs, spine & hip bones are very easy to see
- Obvious waist & abdominal tuck
- Very little fat can be felt



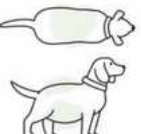
### Ideal

- Well-proportioned, hourglass figure where ribs are easily felt but not seen
- Visible waist & slight abdominal tuck
- Only a small amount of fat covering



### Overweight

- Ribs are difficult to feel under fat
- Waist is barely visible & no abdominal tuck
- Slightly rounded belly



### Obese

- Ribs can't be felt under thick fat layer
- Obvious fat deposits over shoulders, ribs & hips
- Rounded, sagging belly & no waist

Dogs at a healthy weight typically have a visible abdominal tuck, ribs that can be easily felt (though not prominently seen), and a well-proportioned body shape. Keeping dogs within a healthy weight range helps reduce the risk of joint stress, injury, decreased endurance, shortened working careers, diabetes, and heart disease.

**If you're concerned your dog may be overweight, small adjustments can make a big difference:**

- Offer high-quality, balanced, measured meals
- Adjust portion sizes as needed
- Maintain consistent daily activity
- Ensure adequate rest
- Choose low-impact exercise options like swimming or short walks

**Supporting a healthy weight helps your dog stay comfortable, capable, and ready to thrive in both work and everyday life.**
